PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Online/Distance Learning Program is an outreach of State Fire/Rescue Training designed to better serve the needs of students through the delivery of high-quality hybrid and web-based fire/rescue science technology classes that will lead to an Associate of Applied Science in Fire/Rescue Technology and other related Fire/Rescue/EMS certificates.

ACCESSIBILITY AND FLEXIBILITY

To improve student accessibility the traditional “classroom” portions will be delivered and supplemented through online content and information; written assignments and assessments will be placed online. Skills practicals will be condensed and offered in hybrid courses. Web-based courses are offered in their entirety online.

Returning KCTCS students may register for these courses following the method utilized in their home campus. Once you are admitted as a KCTCS student, use title of the course and the 5 digit course number listed on the back of this pamphlet to enroll in specific courses.

TUITION AND REQUIRED MATERIALS

The Online/Distance Learning Program follows the same tuition schedule implemented by KCTCS. Fractional credits are pro-rated from the standard per-hour rate.

Online/Distance Learning Courses require a computer, internet access (High speed is recommended), and textbooks.

OTHER INFORMATION

Most hybrid classes require at least one skill practical session which is typically held in Elizabethtown. As demand grows, other locations will be offered. Dates for these practicals will be provided by the instructor when the class begins.
