- The candidate shall be provided with a tool for pulling locks. (K-tool, A-tool, key tool, halligan tool, flat-head axe, etc.)
- The candidate shall be given the instructions below before beginning this task.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. "The candidate, given a door with a cylinder lock and various entry tools including the A-tool, K-tool and Key tool, shall demonstrate the procedures for pulling the lock and opening the door to gain entry."

Minimum PPE: Full PPE with SCBA.
