1. "The candidate, given a charged hoseline, shall demonstrate:
 - a) Opening and closing the nozzle
 - b) Adjusting the fog pattern
 - c) Adjusting the GPM/Flow setting

Minimum PPE: Full PPE without SCBA.

1. Holds the nozzle in one hand and the hose in the other.		
2. Straightens the hose behind them.		
3. Anchors the hose to the ground with the foot and supports the hose on the hip.		
4. Opens the nozzle slowly.		
5. Adjusts the fog pattern.		
6. Adjusts the flow/GPM.		
7. Closes the nozzle slowly.
