INSTRUCTIONS TO THE MONITOR/EVALUATOR

2. The candidate shall be provided with two (2) pike poles.
3. The candidate shall be given the instructions below before beginning the task.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. "The candidate, given the salvage cover and pike poles provided, shall demonstrate the construction of a water chute."

Minimum PPE: Full PPE without SCBA.

1. Spreads salvage cover out on floor.		
2. Lays a pike pole along opposite sides of the cover, leaving the hooks above the edge.		
3. Folds the edges of the cover over each pike pole.		
4. Rolls the pike poles toward each other until the chute is the desired width.		
5. Completes construction of the water chute.		
6. Elevates the hooks so water can be channeled away.
