**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE MONITOR/EVALUATOR**



1. The candidate shall be provided with a charged, 2-1/2" or 3" firehose consisting of three (3) sections.
2. The candidate shall be given an assistant, additional section of hose and a hose clamp.
3. The candidate shall be informed that the middle section of the charged line is to be replaced.
4. The candidate shall be given the instructions below before beginning the task.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE**

**1. "The candidate, given the firehose provided and a hose clamp, shall demonstrate procedures for replacing a burst section of hose. An assistant shall serve as the nozzleman."**

*Minimum PPE: Full PPE without SCBA.*

1. Places the hose clamp at least 5 feet behind the female coupling of the damaged section of hose, on the supply side.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
