Skill No. 5-75 PERFORMANCE CRITERIA AND INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE MONITOR/EVALUATOR

1. Candidate shall be provided with a blanket or coat.
2. The candidate shall be provided with a "victim" on which to demonstrate this skill.
3. The candidate shall be given the instructions below before beginning the task.

INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. "The candidate, having an *unconscious victim*, shall demonstrate a blanket drag."

Minimum PPE: Full PPE with SCBA.

PERFORMANCE

1. Turn the victim over (if necessary) so that victim is on his/her back.		
2. Spreads blanket or coat beside victim, extends above victims head.		
3. Kneels beside victim on side opposite the blanket or coat.		
4. Rolls victim up onto side, grasping hip and shoulder.		
5. Gathers blanket or coat against back of victim.		
6. Rolls victim back onto blanket or coat.		
7. Prepares for drag by wrapping excess blanket or coat material around victim.		
8. Kneels at victims head, grasps blanket or coat materials on each side of victims head.		
9. Lifts blanket or coat enough to lift victims head and shoulders off floor.		
10. Drags victim to safety a minimum of 15 feet.
